RE: **COVID-19 update**



As infection rates continue to decline, our government has announced that almost all COVID-19 public health restrictions will be lifted in Alberta on Canada Day (**July 1**) as the province prepares to enter the final stage of its COVID-19 reopening plan.

### **City Mask Bylaw:**

Last Friday, Edmonton city council voted to end the mandatory mask bylaw by July 1, while Calgary will have its mask mandate in place until at least July 5. Therefore, all staff, visitors and people in service are required to wear a face covering in all indoor workplaces in Calgary, except when a person is working alone in an office or a safely distanced cubicle, and where there is an appropriate barrier in place.

### **What Stage 3 means for Chrysalis:**

While this is an exciting time for many, we recognize that this could cause fear and uncertainty for others. Safety continues to be our top priority at Chrysalis. Our health screening practices will remain in effect throughout the summer as an additional precaution along with stringent cleaning practices. Masks and social distancing may no longer be mandatory, if anyone prefers to wear a mask in the facility and remain physically distanced as much as possible, we will support this.

### **Vaccines:**

We cannot legally obtain information on whether staff or people in service are vaccinated, however, Chrysalis continues to strongly encourage all staff and people in service to book their COVID-19 vaccine. Booking for the first and second dose is now open for anyone in Alberta over the age of 12.
